

## BMHS Local Scholarship Descriptions

Please use the BMHS Local Scholarship Application form for the following scholarships. You may use the same information for all scholarships; simply type in the name of the scholarship at the top for each different scholarship for which you want to apply. **Please complete and return a separate application and essay for each scholarship.**

**Antioch Baptist Church:** The recipient will be chosen by mission committee of the church. The recipient must pursue a degree through a college, university or vocational school. There is a separate form that must be submitted along with the school application.

**Ballard County Bus Drivers:** The recipient is chosen by a committee of bus drivers for Ballard County Schools. **No application is necessary.**

**Ballard County Conservation District:** The recipient of this scholarship must be willing to go into the agriculture or agri-business field of study. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

**Ballard County Education Association:** The recipient of this scholarship will be the child or grandchild of a BCEA member. He/she must apply through the BMHS guidance office, and have at least a B grade average. The recipient will receive a check for \$500 upon enrollment in a college or university.

**Ballard County Farm Bureau:** The recipient may plan to attend either a college or vocational/technical school. The recipient's parent or guardian must be a member of Ballard County Farm Bureau.

**Ballard County Homemakers:** The recipient must major in home economics, agriculture or related fields. The student may receive the scholarship up to (but not over) four consecutive years.

**Ballard Memorial Alumni Association:** The recipient shall demonstrate high academic standards. Citizenship and financial need shall be a consideration.

**Ballard Rural Telephone Co-op:** The recipient must be a student whose parent or guardian is a member of and is served by Ballard Telephone Corp. The recipient shall have a 3.0 GPA or better and must pursue further education at a university, college or vocational/technical school. Upon enrollment, a check for \$1,000 will be sent to the college of the recipient's choice.

**Ballard Weekly:** The recipient will be chosen based on GPA, financial need and interest in public relations, media and news broadcast. The scholarship will be sent to the college of the recipient's choice.

**Barlow First Baptist Church:** Church members will be given first priority in receiving the Dathel Crews Norment, Thomas Taylor Norment, Eva Sanders Moore, Darrel E. "Preacher" Moore and Jerry D. and Connie S. Moore scholarships. These awards are to recognize students who have demonstrated a record of attendance at church services and activities, good moral/ethical character, and have completed high school with a GPA and test scores necessary to continue their education. The committee will evaluate all applicants and determine their merit as recipients. **A separate application must be obtained – please do not use the local scholarship application. The application and checklist must be completed and returned to Barlow First Baptist Church by April 1, 2012.**

**Barlow-Kevil High School Alumni Wanda Crews Stallons Memorial:** The recipient must be a senior cheerleader from BMHS who plans to attend an accredited college or university. Preference will be given to students with a high ACT, GPA, involved in school and community service activities, and church involvement. Scholarship amount is \$250.

**Beatrice Jackson Memorial:** The recipient shall be African-American. Funds may be used to attend a college, university, vocational/technical school or another accredited institution.

**Beta Club:** The recipient must be a senior Beta Club member who exhibits leadership and citizenship, with strong academic ability. The recipient will receive a check for \$100 upon enrollment in an accredited institution.

**Bradley Mayo Memorial:** Applicant must complete an essay related to reasons why he or she would like to receive this scholarship.

**Class of 1957 Memorial:** Applicant must be a descendent of a 1957 graduate of Ballard Memorial High School. He or she must name the class member, and explain his/her relationship to the 1957 graduate.

**Delta Kappa Gamma:** Applicants shall have high scholastic abilities, have financial need, and be entering the field

of education. Applicants must have two letters of recommendation from school officials, an official transcript, and a one-page summary written by the student concerning his or her college interest and intent. **Entry deadline is March 25**; recipient notification deadline is April 8.

**Dr. W.N. Coffee Memorial:** Students shall submit a resume including personal data, academic standing, extracurricular activities, future plans, expected major in school, where the student plans to attend and why he or she should receive this scholarship.

**Elrod Family:** The recipient must be a female who is pursuing a career in a non-traditional field. Award is based on GPA, ACT and financial need. **A separate application must be submitted.**

**First Southern National Bank:** The recipient of this scholarship shall be a student who is a customer of First Southern National Bank or whose parent or guardian is a customer of the bank.

**Frank McGary Memorial:** Applicants will be judged on scholastic ability, financial need and leadership. They must have attended BMHS for four years.

**Gary Enlow Farm Bureau:** This is a separate scholarship from the Ballard County and state Farm Bureau offerings.

**Kerrie Stewart Memorial:** Applicants must plan to attend Western Kentucky University, must have demonstrated leadership qualities in high school, and must have high academic standing. Students planning to major in advertising shall be given priority consideration.

**Kevil Bank:** The recipient of this scholarship will be chosen by committee. Each recipient will receive \$300 for the first school year and \$300 for the second year – NOT the second semester. Recipient must provide proof of registration or enrollment to the Kevil Bank, and/or a copy of their college transcript in order to receive the check.

**LaCenter United Methodist Church:** No description available. Church members will be considered first for the scholarship. **A separate application must be submitted.**

**Larry Reno Memorial:** Character and need are primary concerns for applicants of this scholarship. The recipient is selected by family members through the local application form.

**Louise Littlepage Memorial:** Recipients shall have above-average grades and shall demonstrate high moral caliber. The scholarship may be awarded to a single recipient for one or more years (with a maximum of four).

**Margaret Brunston Memorial (Fraternal Order of Eagles):** The recipient must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and be a resident of Ballard County with an annual income of less than \$20,000. The scholarship is divided into two \$500 awards, one to Ballard Memorial and one to Carlisle County

**Matt Maxey Memorial:** At least two students will receive this scholarship, one football player and one other student. Applicant must have at least a C average, and must write an essay stating why he or she is applying for this specific scholarship. The check will be made to the recipient and the post-secondary school of choice. If the student decides not to attend post-secondary school or drops out, the money is required to be returned to the scholarship fund.

**Mildred Maxberry Memorial:** No description available.

**NOBAA – Art Scholarship:** This scholarship is for students who have presented art projects now or in the past. Applicants must explain any and all interest in the arts.

**Olyn Boyd:** The recipient of this award will be chosen based on financial need, GPA, class rank, leadership qualities and career choice.

**Regions Bank:** The recipient of this scholarship will be chosen by a committee. The award will be submitted to the recipient's school of choice.

**Rev. W.W. Morris Memorial:** This scholarship shall be shared between Ballard Memorial and Carlisle County high schools. A BMHS senior will receive the award in each odd-numbered year.

**Scott Beadles Memorial:** The recipient must be a student who plans to enroll in college with a music major/minor. Financial need, GPA and leadership accomplishments will be considered. This scholarship is determined by the band director and /or committee.

**Tot Waldon Family:** Preference will be given to a senior who plans to attend MSU or WKCTC. Financial need is a

priority.

**Waldon Lodge Scholarship:** The recipient of this scholarship will be picked on needs-based criteria at a GPA of 3.0. A committee will be formed to choose the recipients. The scholarship is presented by Ricky Waldon and family.

**Welch-Abanatha Memorial:** The recipient of this scholarship will be chosen by a committee that includes the superintendent, principal, counselor and two other members. Students will be considered based on academic ability and financial need.

**Wickliffe Fire Department William J. Reed Memorial:** The recipient should be willing to pursue a career in the medical technician field or firefighting.

**Wickliffe Homemakers' Club:** The recipient shall be a female from the Wickliffe area planning to further her education in home economics or a related field. Financial need will be a priority.

**Wickliffe Masonic Lodge:** The recipient of this award will be chosen based on financial need, character and academic standing.

**Zearle Davis/Gayle Perry Memorial Scouting Scholarship:** Applicants must have been Boy Scouts and attained the rank of First Class or higher. The recipient must be a resident of Ballard County, have at least a 2.0 GPA and must pursue further education in a college, university, vocational/technical school or an associated institution.
