

Mail order programs, correspondence course oriented programs, etc., are not normally considered as eligible programs.

For vocational school bound candidates, the **Scholarship Committee** will develop a list of regional vocational schools. Preference will then be given to these schools.

- Scholarships will be awarded for out-of-state programs, when the candidate demonstrates that the desired vocationally oriented program is not available in Kentucky, or if the candidate is able to obtain a waiver of out-of-state tuition. If the **Scholarship Committee** agrees with the request, full consideration will be given as though the institutions were located in the State of Kentucky. For university bound candidates, preference will be given to the following out-of-state Universities:

Mississippi State University
Auburn University

The University of Alabama (Tuscaloosa)
The University of Missouri at Rolla

4. DESIGNATION AND RECOGNITION OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The recipient of the scholarship will be identified as either an **Eva Sanders Moore**, or **Dathel Crews Norment**, or **Darrell E. Moore**, or **Thomas Taylor Norment Scholar**, or **Jerry Don and Connie Norment Moore Scholar**. With the recipient's permission, attempts will be made to give recognition in the local newspapers, at high school graduation, at a church sponsored recognition ceremony, etc. A plaque or other suitable listing of recipients may be created, (should not be paid for with scholarship funds), and displayed at Ballard Memorial High School, and/or at the church where the recipient attends.

5. CONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Some guidelines for continuation of a scholarship are:

- Should continue with active church affiliation at home church or transfer membership to a church at or near the University
- Should continue to demonstrate good moral and ethical principles
- Should maintain a term-by-term and a cumulative grade point average of at least a B
- Should maintain enrollment in the major program and institution initially approved by the **Scholarship Committee**

If the student withdraws from classes at the university or vocational school, within the tuition-refund period, the awarded scholarship funds should be returned to the First Baptist Church of Barlow and used for the benefit of other scholarship recipients.
