

University of Kentucky Academic Scholarship Descriptions

The University of Kentucky provides a competitive scholarship application for higher-valued scholarships, for students with a minimum test score of 31 ACT or 1360 SAT (math + reading) and minimum unweighted GPA of 3.50 on a 4.00 scale. The postmark deadline to apply for a competitive scholarship is **Jan. 13, 2012**. **In addition to the scholarship application, students applying for a competitive scholarship must have qualifying test scores and high school transcript on file with the Office of Undergraduate Admission by Jan. 13, 2012.**

Please use the University of Kentucky Academic Scholarship Application form for the following scholarships.

The Otis A. Singletary Scholarship - Four-year renewable awards covering the cost of tuition, room and board, plus a yearly stipend of \$1,500.

The Presidential Scholarship - Four-year, renewable awards covering the cost of instate tuition.

The Commonwealth Scholarship - Four-year, renewable awards of \$2,500 per year; Kentucky applicants only.

The National Excellence Scholarship - Four-year awards of \$4,500 per year; non-resident applicants only.

These University of Kentucky scholarships will be awarded to eligible students, provided the student is admitted and has the qualifying test score and unweighted GPA on file with the Office of Undergraduate Admissions by **March 1, 2012**. Minimum test score requirements are based on the composite or total score from one test date. Combined scores, also known as a superscore, from two or more tests will not be considered. No application is required for the following automatic scholarships:

Flagship Scholarship - automatically offered to incoming freshmen whose highest ACT score is 26-27 or SAT (M+CR) is 1170-1240, and who achieve a 3.30 unweighted high school GPA. The Flagship Scholarship provides \$1,500 during the freshman year and is non-renewable.

Provost Scholarship - automatically offered to incoming freshmen whose minimum ACT score is 28 or SAT (M+CR) is 1250, and who achieves a 3.30 unweighted high school GPA. The Provost Scholarship provides \$1,500 per year, for up to four years of undergraduate study.

Kentucky Governor's Scholars and/or Governor's School for the Arts - automatically offered to students that complete the GSP or GSA summer programs. A Presidential Scholarship will automatically be offered to GSP/GSA students with 28+ ACT and 3.30 unweighted GPA. A Provost Scholarship will automatically be offered to all other GSP/GSA students.

Please make sure you have met all requirements for the scholarship(s) for which you are applying.

Don't forget to show your appreciation to the scholarship committees that work hard to choose recipients for their scholarships. This is not an easy task.
